

The initiative provides an opportunity for the Council to showcase the new 'Place' brand for 'Enniskillen, The Island Town' which reflects the key attributes of the town as Ireland's only island town surrounded by natural and built heritage, and miles of Lough shore.

The Place brand captures the diverse mix of people, businesses and visitors in Enniskillen and capturing the town's unique cultural, historic and tourism offering, which has opportunities for everyone to explore on water and land. A strapline, 'Naturally Welcoming' has been developed to encompass the rich nature, location, people and personality of the town.

The Place brand aims to increase the visibility of the town with a consistent message that will be delivered through a marketing campaign to support recovery across the various sectors; retail, hospitality and visitor and night-time economy.

Speaking about the new Place brand, Chair of Fermanagh and Omagh District Council Cllr Errol Thompson said:

"Fermanagh and Omagh District Council is delighted to support the "Enjoy Enniskillen" initiative.

The Council is committed to working in partnership with all key stakeholders, including the business community, to aid the recovery and revitalisation of the town centre to ensure its long term sustainability and has already delivered a range of initiatives aimed at promoting confidence in our town centres as we emerge from the most challenging 18 months in living memory.

The 'Enniskillen Island Town' brand perfectly encapsulates the essence of Enniskillen, and what makes it unique.

We are the only island town on the Island of Ireland, and we are justifiably proud of the "naturally welcoming" outlook of the people and the experiences we provide for those who live nearby, those who come to visit, and those with family connections to Enniskillen. With an abundance of activities, retail offerings and hospi-



tality experiences, I am confident that our business and tourism will be enriched with this Place brand."

Fermanagh and Omagh District Council continues to support town centre recovery and revitalisation through the facilitation of Covid-19 Business Recovery Grants and Business Support Services.

The Council are also delivering capital projects such as the ongoing

Enniskillen public realm scheme, the completion of improvement works at the Buttermarket that have enhanced the aesthetics of the site and also increased accessibility. Enhancement works at the junction of Regal Pass and Wellington Road will be undertaken to better connect the town centre with the Erneside Shopping Centre and to improve user experience of the town. In tandem with this new gateway features are being developed to replace existing signage and install new features to improve the sense of arrival into the town.

Enniskillen Castle recently improved its provision with the introduction of a newly completed reduced Changing Place facility which aims to support people with access needs, a welcome addition for those visiting the Castle and the town central

Alongside the physical improvements the Council are also ensuring a warm welcome awaits visitors to Enniskillen with the return of the very popular 'Live and Local' music programme each Saturday lunchtime in August. The music programme brings the Diamond to life and supports the arts and our local artists

The Council is also planning its seasonal events programme. Central to the planning 'The Christmas Lights Festival'.

The facades of buildings in the town centre will be transformed using festive 3D mapping and light projections to deliver a positive Christmas experience, increase visitation and stimulate spend in the local economy supporting the local business sector. A programme of festive family focussed events will be developed along with music and street animation.

Mi-Rewards is the first customer loyalty scheme on the Island of Ireland and it rewards shoppers for choosing local. Whether you're having a meal out and a few drinks in the town, or you're buying your weekly groceries, you can earn reward points and be in with the chance of winning the monthly prize. Experience Enniskillen is the marketing arm of Enniskillen BID and is the platform we use to market Enniskillen via Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and YouTube. 




